## **YOUTH ART MONTH FLAG DESIGN** **2024-2025 Theme: Healing Through Art**

Annually, during the month of March, student designed flags from every state are flown at the National Art Education Association Conference. The winning entry will be made into a flag and displayed at the National Flag Ceremony at the National Art Education Association Conference where the student and their teacher will be honored! The winning entry also is displayed during our state conference as well as the YAM Spring Exhibition!

### **Entry Guidelines:**

Only **one entry** per TAEA member is allowed. If you teach at multiple campuses, you can submit an entry per campus.

The design must incorporate the theme “Healing Through Art” and be representative of the state of Texas.

Students must include the state name of Texas in the design and include the words “Youth Art Month” if possible

The information on the official flag form **MUST** be filled in digitally and include the flag design. Do not upload a separate image of the flag design. **It MUST be placed and fit within the space on the form.**

Students in Pre-K-12th Grade are eligible to participate!

Upload the Flag Design, digitally filled in Artwork Permission and Artwork Release forms to the designated District shared folder by **Friday, December 13, 2024.**

The winning entry will be announced January 2025 after all entries are juried!

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# SPRING EXHIBITION ARTWORK PREPARATION

THIS IS WHAT YOUR ARTWORK SHOULD LOOK LIKE FOR THE YAM SPRING EXHIBITION.

- FRONT - 2D ARTWORK**
- WEIGH NO MORE THAN 12 lbs.
  - Not too heavy to hang with Velcro dots
  - Loose cover sheet to protect artwork
  - Do not tape over the forms
- BACK - 2D Artwork**
- Strongly backing (cardboard or mat board)
  - Attach (optional) Student/Parent Artwork Release Form
  - Attach to the direction the art should hang OR draw an arrow indicating hanging direction



3D artwork example

- 3D ARTWORK**
- 3D media that is selected must fit into a 6" x 12" x 12" box
  - weighing no more than 12 lbs.
  - Must be sturdy and able to stand alone without support
  - No sharp or protruding parts that would be dangerous to handle
  - All parts must be safely secured to a base and ready for immediate installation
  - include original Student/Parent Artwork Release Form in box



## 2D media selected must:

- **NOT** exceed 18" x 24" (including 2"-3" mat)
- have a white or black mat (2"-3"max)
- be light enough to hang with Velcro dots
- fit in a poster board box
- include a **LOOSE** cover sheet.

Please do **NOT** tape any coversheets to the artwork.



## 3D media selected must:

- fit into a 6"x12"x12" box
  - weigh no more than 12 lbs.
- If there are loose elements to the 3D media such as sand, pebbles, etc. please package those items in a Ziploc bag and include in your box.

## STEP 1

Write a letter to your local officials and include the proclamation form linked below!

## STEP 2

Submit a Youth Art Month appearance request for your event!  
**The Mayor's or Governor's secretary will probably contact you regarding this matter.**

## STEP 3

Call your local official's office to follow up one week after the letter and appearance requests are sent.

## STEP 4

Pick up the approved proclamation with the mayor's/governor's signature and duplicate for distribution!

The Board of Education will usually add the request to the agenda, and public officials are usually eager to participate in Youth art month if you will just ask them!

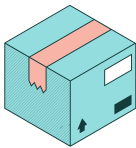
