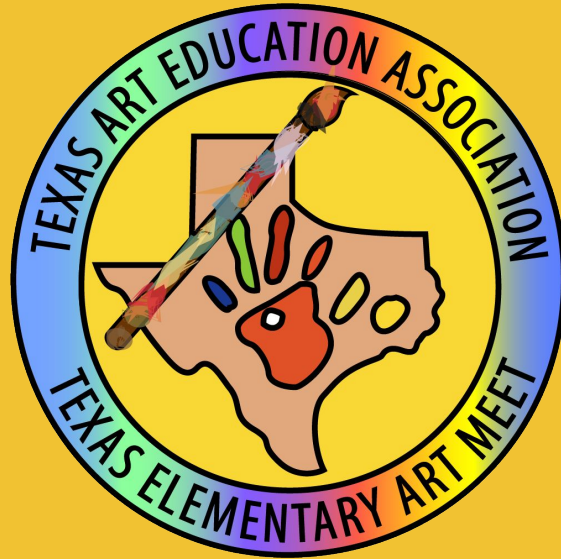


# TEAM Intent Form



**Completing Online Student Intent Form**

# VASE

Regional Events for High School VASE and Junior VASE will be **in-person**. TEAM will still be adjudicated online. Three things will be required:

- Good-quality photo of the artwork (no mat needed for photo). Photo should be cropped and straightened; upload in JPEG format, no larger than 10MB. Only one image can be uploaded; multiple images of 3D & 2D relief artworks should be presented as a collage (2-5 images in collage).
- **Student Intent & Artwork Identification Form is completed online.**
- Student Agreement & Artwork Release Form will be printed, signed, scanned or photographed, and uploaded.

# Online Student Intent Form:

**The VASE Student Intent & Artwork Identification Form will be filled out and submitted online for TEAM.**

- Teachers enter artwork online as usual; entry and editing deadlines have changed. Teachers can print out a Practice Intent Form for student planning.

# Filling out the Online Intent Form:

- Teacher logs in to the VASE website, goes to the Teacher Dashboard, and clicks on the **Online Intent Form** link.
- Teacher begins filling in the fields required; *the name, school, teacher, title, etc., are not editable here. Only the teacher can edit this information in the usual way, through Student Entries.*
- **SAVE the entry; DO NOT SUBMIT until completed.**
- **Deadline for completion/submission of the Intent Form is 11:59 pm, on that date.**

- **All THREE parts of the Artwork Entry MUST be completed AND uploaded by 11:59 pm on the Friday the week before your Regional Event.**

*It is recommended that you complete TEAM entries **as soon as possible after the editing deadline** in order to have plenty of time to photograph and upload completed artwork images and other documentation.*



## Questions & Reminders: *Other “paperwork”*

- ***Student Agreement & Artwork Release Forms*** will be available for teachers to print . All students must sign (and parent if under 18) and return the form to be uploaded to the teacher dashboard.
- ***Regional Certification Forms*** must be printed and signed by the principal prior to the event and uploaded.
- ***Regional Directors will send instructions for turning both of these forms in; they must be in the Regional Director’s possession by Event Day.***
